

# TECHNICAL ROPE RESCUE (TRR): TECHNICIAN LEVEL

Meets Requirements for N.F.P.A. 1670

In 1999, Rescue 3 International revised the curriculum to meet the requirements of the new NFPA 1670 Standard on Technical Rescue for water and rope. Training is available at the awareness, operations, and technician levels.

## TECHNICAL ROPE RESCUE (TRR): TECHNICIAN LEVEL

This five-day course meets the requirements for the **technician level** of *NFPA 1670 Standard* for technical rope incidents. This is one day of classroom instruction followed by four field days. Students will advance from basic over-the-bank rescues to progressively more vertical scenarios. Students are trained in preplanning and size-up of rope rescue operations; knots, hitches and anchor systems; belay operations; ascending and descending; raising and lowering systems; and, patient packaging and litter attending among other disciplines.

### Equipment Needs:

- Climbing or fire helmet
- Coveralls or heavy clothing
- Full body harness (a sit harness and chest harness can be substituted)
- Boots
- Leather gloves
